### **Membership and Culture**

- Terrace has continued to be an exciting and desirable venue for large-scale music events, twie to
  three times a week with performers even requesting to be invited back to Terrace for repeat
  performances.
- Every Friday, we have a members-only events night. Events this semester have included Valentine making, Christmas decorating, a Secret Santa, and wine and cheese nights.
- We have recently enjoyed a number of culturally-based food nights, with our head chef creating meals specifically geared towards ethnic themes such as Thai, Indian and Korean food nights etc.

#### **Sustainability and (Food=Love)**

- We have reusable plastic cups for tap nights, which are washed and redistributed by officers and members on duty (1 member duty required per year).
- We are continuing to provide great vegetarian and vegan options at every meal.
- Our kitchen composts all of our pre-production food scraps in the backyard.
- We have implemented a one-entry only policy each time through the servery. Members having been taking smaller portions as a result and saving food.
- Sunday Wednesday we have been offering a fourth meal that starts at 10:30pm and ends around midnight. This has proved to be a great way to get rid of leftovers (though we do not exclusively use leftovers for these meals.)

## **Technology and House Renovations**

- We built a plexiglass DJ booth to house our member-DJs and protect their equipment from spilled liquids.
- OIT installed a second wifi router on the second floor, alleviating overloaded network issues.
- We have installed four hammocks in the solarium on the first floor and repainted the Willard Room.
- We have repaired a broken subwoofer.
- The heating system was also repaired/improved.
- Several additional smoke detectors were installed around the house.

### **Charity and Community Outreach**

- Our annual charity event "Dare to Care" allowed us to donate over \$1000 to Petey Greene.
- Our annual Drag Ball was a huge success. This was held with the LGBT Center to promote LGBT life on campus. We collected toiletry and food donations at the door.
