## **Terrace Club Community Service, Sustainability & Improvements Report**

### **Community Outreach**

- Terrace maintains a community service chair, responsible for organizing Truckfest on the club's behalf and coordinating community service projects within the membership
- Several Terrace members volunteer their time as prison tutors (with Petey Greene and SPEAR), English teachers, organizers, and activists, both in Princeton and in nearby Trenton, Newark, Philadelphia, and NYC
- Terrace remains the sole eating club that offers music on a biweekly (and sometimes even more often!) basis, free of charge to the whole University community
- English as a Second Language (ESL) classes between members and staff have been in the works by several Terrace members
- Several members are in the process of establishing a connection with the University based in food recovery and donations to homeless shelters, specifically food from eating clubs like Terrace and the dining halls too

### **Education/Career Development**

- We are in the process of establishing weekly professor dinners in the house to help engage students with research and education of all types
- Hosted Dr. William Barber of the Black Lives Matter campaign for Q&A session with all interested members
- Terrace serves as an educational/social hub for many of its members, who use it as a study space and take advantage of our wifi, printing office, and comfortable accommodations

### **Sustainability**

- Terrace works with AgriArk, a food composting company that utilizes 100% of food waste it collects
- We have clearly labeled refuse and recycling bins throughout the house to

- segregate paper, glass, metal, & plastic recycling from trash products
- We have constructed our own greenhouse and grow 10 different herbs year round to be used in the meals prepared at the club
  - We grow greens such as arugula, spinach, and kale on a small, open garden patch to be used for special lunch salads in the club
  - We are in the process of erecting rain barrels to capture runoff from the roof to be used later as viable water after purification

### **Capital Improvements**

- Terrace is in the midst of a capital campaign aimed at renovation to better accommodate its larger membership. Renovations will include the addition of a multi-use performance space.
- Progress has been made in the last year in upgrading Terrace's plumbing and ventilation
